Once on board there is a full boat briefing and light breakfast available.

Once you arrive at the dive site after the briefing you complete first dive, usually 1 hour in time. On board fruits, cookies and toast available.

The second dive is after a 1 hour surface interval minimum.

After that dive there is a hot that buffet lunch is served during the surface interval.

Third dive completed after surface interval then return to the pier.

You arrive back to your hotel between 5 and 6pm depending on the dive sites.





Number of Dives/Site selection:

We plan a two or three dives per day onboard, these are subject to weather conditions and security/safety issues. Dive site selection will be made by the Captain or Tour Leader.

What diver certification level is needed:

Everyone is welcome on board, no matter what level your certification. Dive groups and site selection will be chosen to meet your safety, comfort and diving ability – and is subject to the discretion of the Tour Leader. Our professional dive crew will take you on the easy route or to another site if you don't like currents. If you are up for it, we'll take you right into it for all the action the site offers!

Dive Guides and Diver Safety:

Our experienced dive crew would be delighted to assist you. Nitrox fills and courses are available on board to enhance your diving safety. Please allow 18 hours between last dive and flying. Guests are requested to show diving certification cards on checking in and are strongly recommended to have valid dive insurance (Padi, Dan or equivalent).

Water Temperature and Wetsuit recommendations:

The Andaman Sea with its usually clear blue waters, great visibility has water temperatures of approx 26-28 degrees – a 3-5 mm shorty is okay with most guests comfortable with a 3-5mm long.

Equipment on board:

Full rental equipment is available. Please advise your rental equipment needs including sizes when you book. MV Scuba Fun carries mostly 12 litre aluminum tanks plus some 15 litre aluminum tanks available. Tank valves are international although some DIN tanks are available on board. Please let us know your requirements when you book. Any dive equipment failure or loss will require you to rent a replacement from Scuba Cat Diving at our published rates. If Scuba Cat Diving equipment is lost/damaged, full replacement cost will be charged at the discretion of the Tour Leader. Published equipment prices are available on board.

Electrical current and plugs:

220 volts is standard throughout the boat.

Meals:

Please advise any special meal requirements on the guest information form.

Currency:

Please pay all on board costs in Thai Baht. Please bring small notes, we do not carry much change.

What should I bring:

Items you may need on board are bathing suits, shorts, t-shirts, sunscreen and a light weight jacket or sweater and of course a smile!

Insurance:

You need 2 types of insurance when planning your dive holiday – 1) Diving insurance is strongly recommended due to the high cost for you should you have a diving accident and require check which Dan area can cover you.

2) General travel/cancellation insurance. If you are unable to make your dive trip and the date has past our cancellation terms and conditions we are very sorry but regardless of the circumstances we cannot refund or transfer to another date.

Medical Assistance:

We are prepared to handle most accident or medical emergencies. Our dive crews are first aid trained and we have an extensive first aid kit on board plus loads of emergency oxygen. Please bring any of your own medications that you may need. You can help as well by making sure you are in good condition for diving – prevention is always better than the cure. Please remember to dive safely and to make sure your Dan Diver's Alert Network or other dive insurance is up to date.
